

RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Shelburne that the following By-Law be and the same is hereby enacted and the Clerk is hereby instructed to advertise the notice of publication in the local paper.

TOWN OF SHELBURNE

CURFEW BY-LAW

1996

1. This By-Law shall be known as and may be cited as the “Curfew By-Law”.
2. No person under sixteen (16) years of age shall walk or be on any road, street or sidewalk in the Town of Shelburne between the hours of eleven-thirty (11:30) o’clock in the evening weekdays, twelve-thirty (12:30) o’clock in the morning on Friday and Saturday and six (6:00) o’clock on the following morning except as hereinafter provided.
3. The Provisions of Section 2 of the By-Law shall not apply to any person under the age of sixteen (16) years or to the parents, guardians or person with whom such person resides who is on any road, street or sidewalk between the hours aforesaid and who is accompanied by one of his or her parents, legally appointed guardian or the person heaving care and custody of the said person.
4. Any person under the age of sixteen (16) years who habitually walks, loiters or is in the road, street or sidewalk in the Town after eleven-thirty (11:30) o’clock in the evening weekdays, twelve-thirty (12:30) o’clock in the morning on Friday and Saturday, who after being notified by the Mayor, a Councillor, policeman or Constable not to walk, loiter or be on the road, street or sidewalk of the Town after the said hour at night and walks, loiters or is found to be on any such road, street or sidewalk in the Town after the said hour at night, unless attended by one of his or her parents, legally appointed guardian or the person having the care and custody of the said person, shall on conviction thereof be liable to a penalty not exceeding One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.) and non-payment thereof to imprisonment for a period not exceeding Forty-five (45) days.
5. Any person under the age of Sixteen (16) years found offending against this By-Law may be apprehended or brought before a Judge of a Family Court and dealt with as provided under the Children and Family Services Act and Family Court Act.
6. All former Curfew By-Laws by the Town of Shelburne are hereby repealed and this By-Law substituted therefore.
