**An Act Respecting Relief  
From Liability of the  
Town of Shelburne**

Be it enacted by the Governor and Assembly as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the *Shelburne (Town) Relief from Liability Act*.
2. The Town of Shelburne is not liable for damages
  - (a) caused by the breaking of any reservoir, water main, water service pipe or attachment, or any part of a sewage system, including a storm drain;
  - (b) caused by the interference with the supply of water by the repair or maintenance of the water system; or
  - (c) generally for any action due to the operation of the water system or sewage system, including a storm drain,

unless the damages are shown to be directly due to the negligence of the Town or its employees.
